The current DePaul University Fact File, 1979-84 has been developed as a university information source for you and your office. It presents a wide array of statistics on student enrollment, demographic characteristics, profiles by major groups, financial aid, and other university statistics. The selection of topics covered within this booklet have been drawn from the suggestions and results of a sampled user survey.

Most of the thirty-five tables included within the Fact File provide the reader with a six-year perspective, from 1979 to 1984, that illustrates major trends occurring over the last few years. We have footnoted changes in programs, in student groupings, and in data definitions as accurately as is possible.

This publication has been designed for the readership of DePaul University. Each academic and administrative manager will receive a copy, as will the presidents of the three University Councils. In addition, many DePaul staff members will find this booklet a valuable source for answering information requests. We hope that you will share this publication with your office staff, but that you do not distribute the DePaul Fact File outside of the University.

Our objective, in compiling this databook, is to provide accurate, relevant, and timely information to the University community. However, the interpretation and judicious use of the information is the responsibility of the reader. Entailed in our booklet are statistics intended to answer questions of fact, but these must be combined with sound academic and professional judgment in planning and decision-making.

Since all the computer programming is now in place, we expect to complete the next edition earlier in the academic year. In order that we may make this upcoming publication more useful to you, any suggestions that you may have for its improvement will be welcome.

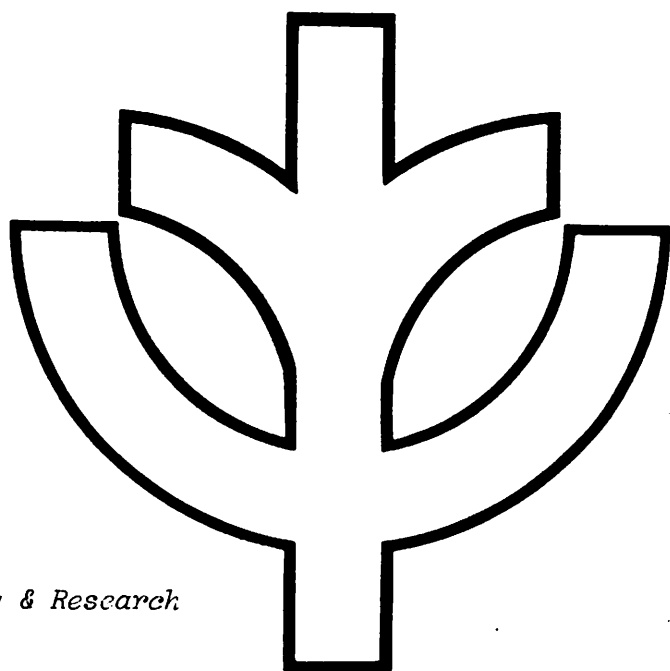
