It presents a wide array of statistics on student enrollment, demographic characteristics, profiles by major groups, financial aid, and other University statistics.

The topics covered in this issue have been expanded to include new student profiles by college. Most of the tables provide the reader with a five-year perspective, from 1981 to 1985, that illustrates major trends occurring over the last few years.

In addition, many DePaul staff members will find this booklet a valuable source for answering information requests.
