

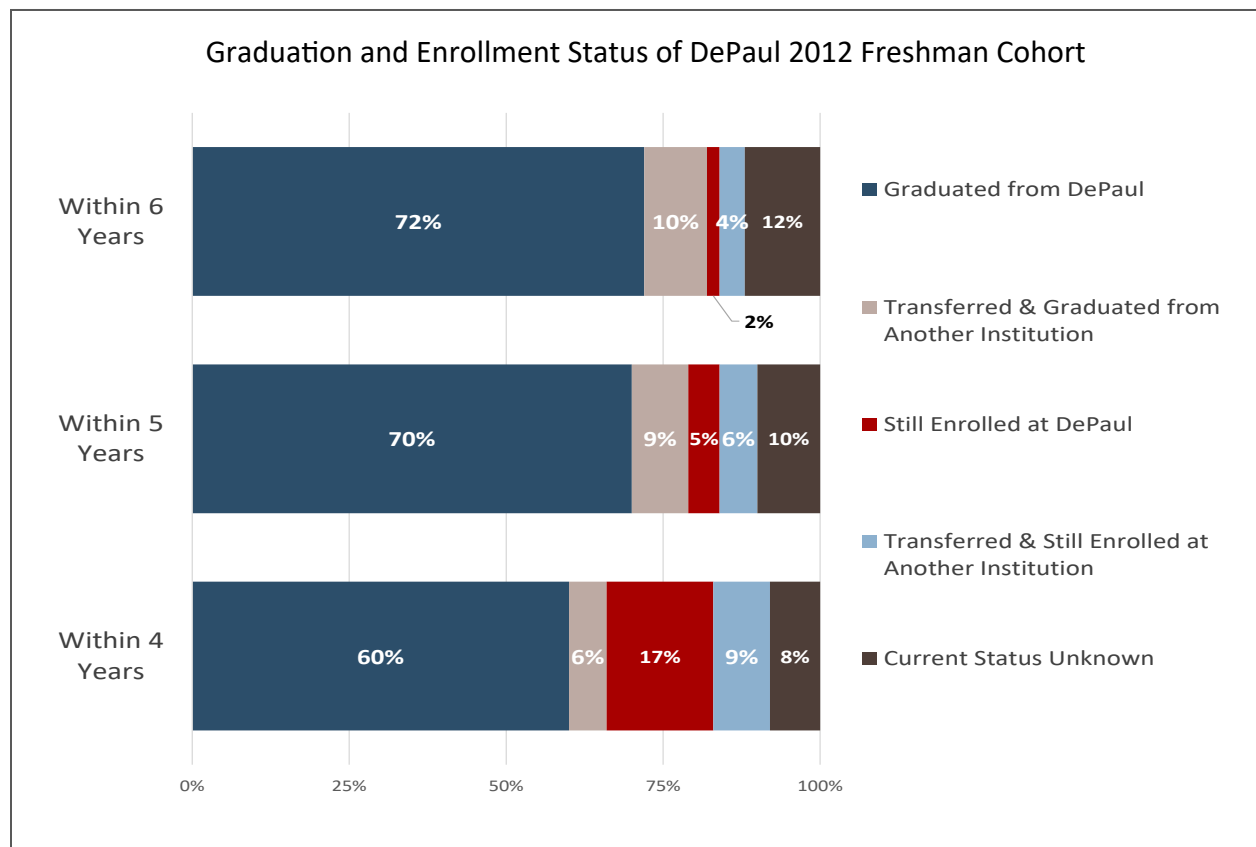
Graduation and Enrollment Status of DePaul's 2012 Freshman Cohort

Eighty-two percent of DePaul's 2012 freshman class graduated from college within six years, according to the most recent data from the Student Achievement Measure (SAM). Seventy-two percent graduated from DePaul and another 10% graduated from another institution.

Using data from the National Clearinghouse, SAM provides a fuller picture of student success. While the majority of students' outcomes are

achieved at DePaul, 14% of the DePaul 2012 cohort had transferred to another institution within six years. Ten percent had graduated and 4% were still enrolled.

The total graduation rate increased notably from four years (66%) to five years (79%), with a smaller gain from five to six years.
