Insights and Outcomes from Institutional Research at DePaul University

University Enrollment Increased +2% in Fall 2023


University enrollment grew by +2% from fall 2022 from 2,968 to 2,943, a -1% decrease. However, to 2023. DePaul saw increases in undergraduate and graduate enrollment (+2% and +3%, respectively) and Law enrollment was -1% compared with 2022.

Undergraduate growth was driven by an increase in continuing students (+3%). Continuing student enrollment was up in six colleges, including CDM (+7%), BUS (+5%), CSH (+2%), LAS (+5%), TTS (+1%) and SOM (+5%).

New freshman enrollment was down slightly

new transfer enrollment was up +5% this year, from 1,044 to 1,092 students. Total new undergraduate enrollment was down -2% because of a decline in new non-degree students.

For graduate students, the story is reversed. New student enrollment was up +18% this year, with a -3% decline in continuing graduate students. New graduate enrollment was up in four colleges, including CDM (+42%), BUS (32%), SOM (+37%) and SCPS (+70%). Total new Law enrollment increased this year by +2%.
