Where do our non-enrolling freshman applicants go?

- In 2003, the Top 10 schools nonenrolling freshman applicants attended included 7 public schools, 2 private institutions and 1 community college.
- These 10 schools account for only 2% of the schools listed, but these schools enrolled 30% of the total non-enrolling applicants in 2003.
- In 2001, the Top 10 list represented 5 publics, 3 privates, and 2 community colleges. Off the list are College of DuPage and New York University, replaced by the University of Iowa and University of Wisconsin at Madison.

- In 2003, four in five nonenrolling applicants (80%) had enrolled at 567 institutions nationwide. Slightly less than half of these schools (43%) enrolled only 1 applicant.
- One in five non-enrolling applicants (19%), or 1,347 students, went to one of three schools Illinois schools: University of Illinois Chicago, University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign, or Loyola.
- These schools were our top three overlap institutions in 2001, and are also the top three destinations for <u>admitted</u> students who did not enroll in 2003.
