## Market Share

Information on DePaul's Market Prominence, Position and Performance

Comparing across selected peer institutions with AACSB accredited programs, Commerce majors tend to have a higher graduation rate than the overall graduation rate at these institution, and a higher rate than Liberal Arts majors.

Using the selected comparison group, DePaul's Commerce graduation rate is <u>higher</u> than:

- UIUC
- St. John's University
- UIC
- ISU

DePaul's Commerce rate is <u>lower</u> than :

- Marquette University
- St. Louis University
- Loyola University.

When 6-year graduation rates are averaged over three years, DePaul's Commerce students graduate at the highest rate of any DePaul college (66.8%), 7 percentage points higher than the overall DePaul rate.

The recent 1996 cohort alone, however, shows Education surpassing Commerce in graduation rates. (Education 74.4%, Commerce 70.2%).




## **DePaul 6-Year Graduation Rates**
