Nursing Projected as Fastest Growing Occupation in the Region

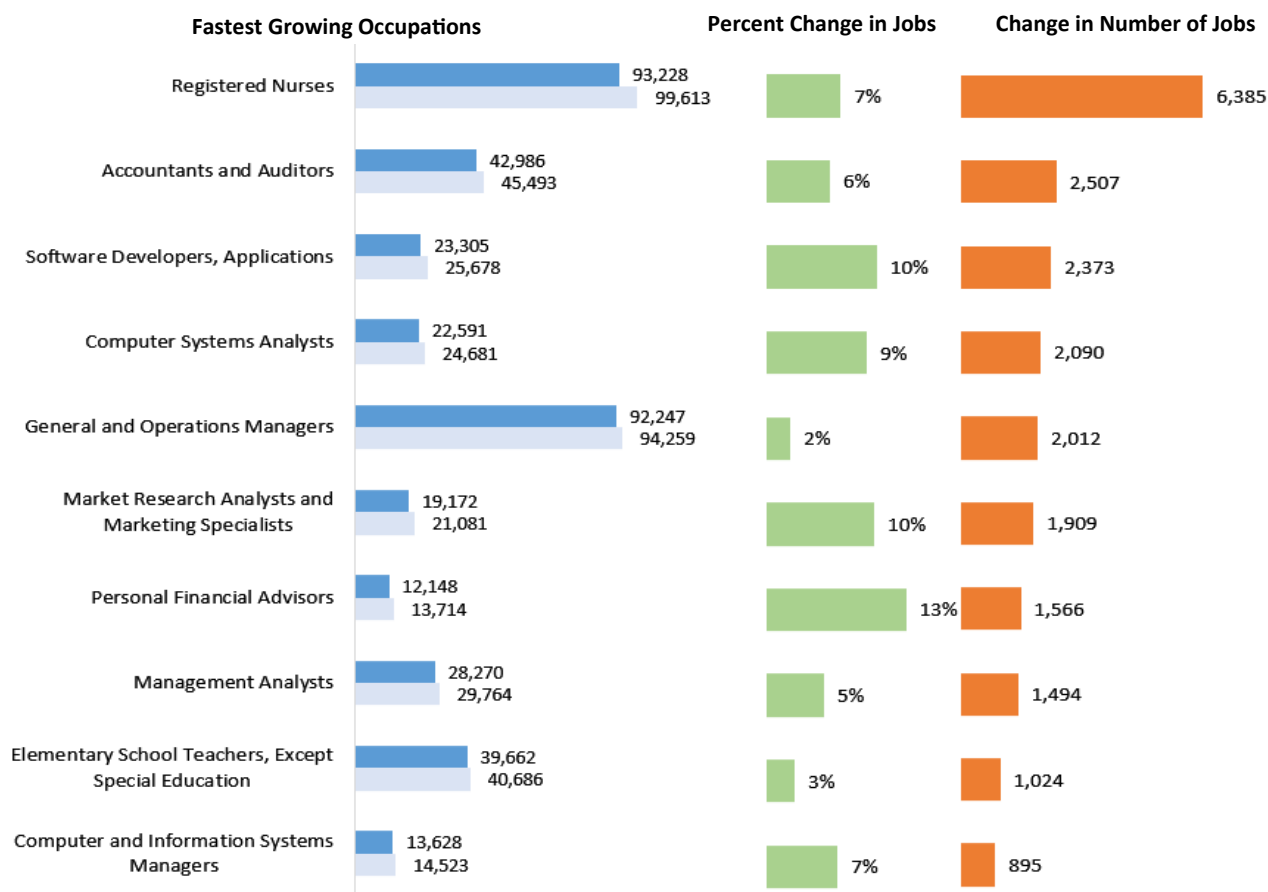
Registered nursing is projected to be the fastest growing occupation between 2018 and 2024, leading the list of the ten fastest-growing occupations in the Chicago region that typically require a bachelor's degree at entry.* Nursing is expected to grow 7 percent during this time and add over 6,000 jobs.

While nursing adds the most jobs, the occupations projected to have the strongest

growth rates are software developers, market research analysts and marketing specialists, and personal financial advisors. Each is projected to grow by 10 percent or more from 2018 to 2024.

In total, the ten fastest growing bachelor's-level occupations are projected to grow by 6 percent and add over 22,000 jobs to the Chicago region during this time.
