

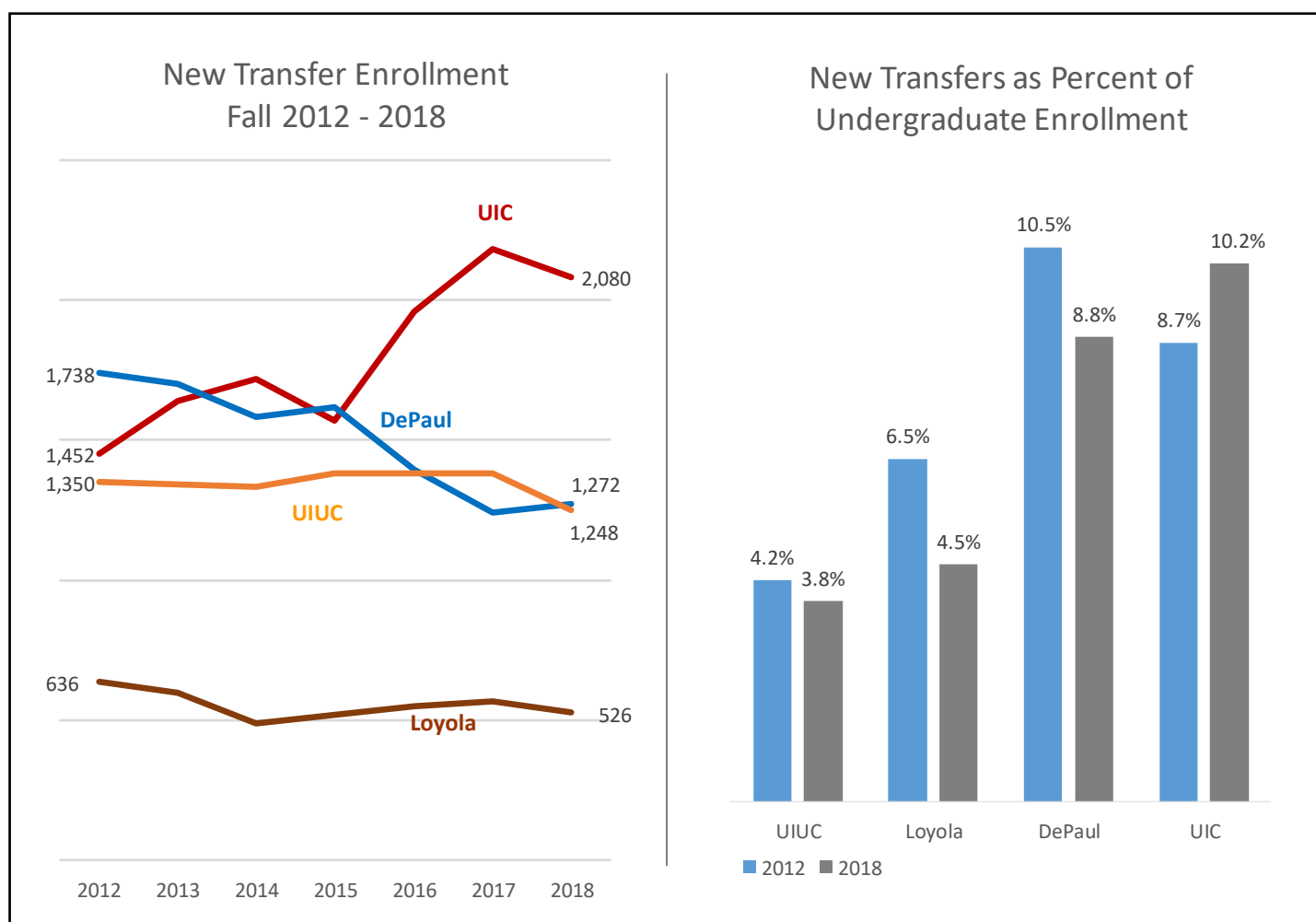
New Fall Transfer Enrollment Trends at DePaul and Local Peers

Illinois new transfer student enrollment declined 13% between 2012 and 2018*, from 56,053 to 48,913 students. During this time, DePaul transfer enrollment declined 27%. Loyola University and University of Illinois Urbana Champaign (UIUC) saw smaller declines of 17% and 8% respectively.

Transfer enrollment at University of Illinois Chicago (UIC), however, grew by 43%, with

most of this growth occurring after 2015.

As a result, in 2018, the proportion of UIC undergraduates who were new transfer students increased, while the proportions decreased for Loyola, DePaul and UIUC.
