2020 Freshman Class is the Largest and Most Diverse in History

DePaul enrolled a record number of 2,774 freshmen in fall 2020, compared with 2,627 in 2019. This is a 6% annual increase in freshmen and a 13% increase since 2016.

In addition to being the largest freshman class, this year's freshman class is the most diverse class in history. The number of freshmen of color increased +17% from 2019 to 2020 and +45% from 2016 to 2020. In 2020, freshmen of color accounted for 49% of all freshmen, an increase of 5% points from 2019.

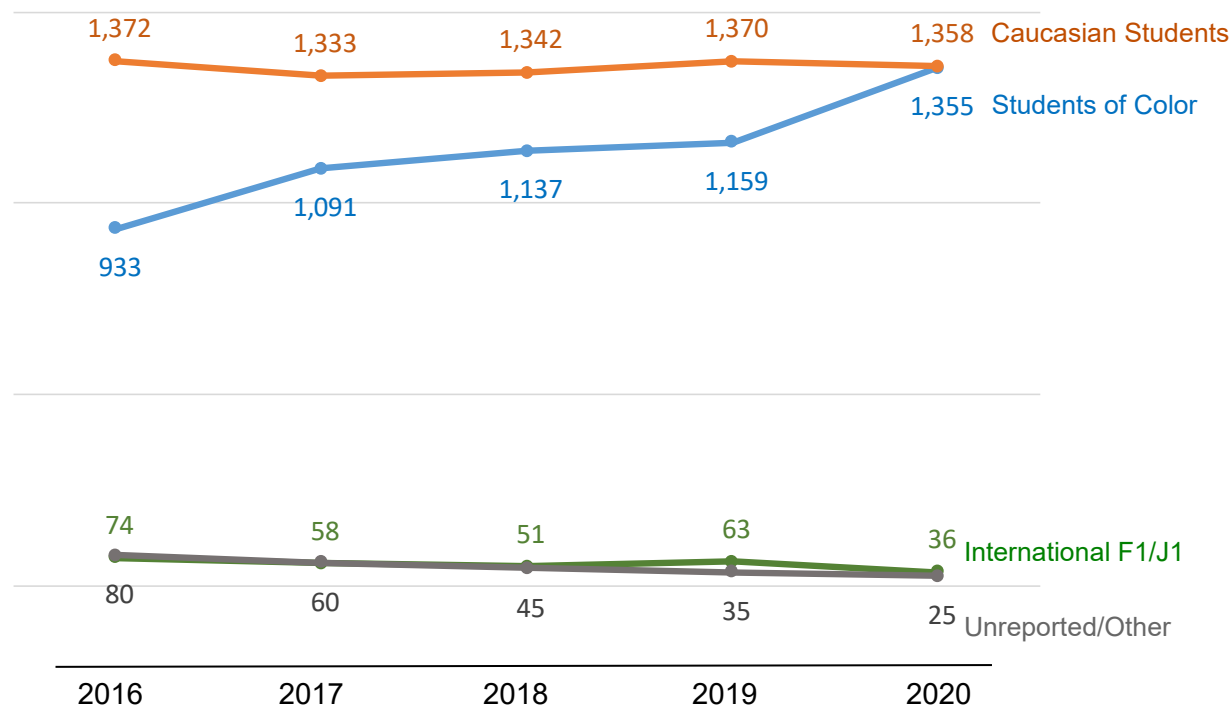
In 2020, DePaul enrolled 703 Hispanic

freshmen, 311 Asian/Pacific Islander/Native Hawaiian freshmen, 192 African American freshmen, 146 multi-racial freshmen and 3 American Indian/Alaska Native freshmen.

The number of international F1/J1 freshmen declined this year. International students account for 1% of the freshman class, down from 3% in 2016.

The number of students who do not report their race/ethnicity has declined annually from 2016 to 2020.
