
Where Do Non-Enrolling Freshman Admits Enroll?

In fall 2021, DePaul admitted 22,294 freshman applications and 2,838 enrolled. The remaining admitted freshmen enrolled at more than 1,000 competitor institutions nationally, according to data from the National Student Clearinghouse.

As in 2019 and 2020, the four largest destinations for non-enrolling admits were University of Illinois at Chicago, University of Illinois at Urbana Champaign, Loyola University Chicago, and Indiana University—Bloomington. The percentage of non-enrolling admits who enrolled at these schools increased from 2020 to 2021, although

University of Illinois Chicago and Loyola, to a lesser extent, were still below pre-pandemic 2019 levels.

Overall, the proportion of fall 2021 non-enrolling admits who enrolled at 2-year institutions declined, compared with 2020, and was lower than 2019. The proportion who enrolled at 4-year institutions, both public and private, returned to near-2019 figures. The proportion who did not enroll at any institution in the fall was lower than in 2020, but remained higher than historical figures.



Notes: This report and the National Student Clearinghouse report are based on admitted applications, not admitted freshman applicants. The number of admissions versus admitted freshmen differs by 10 or fewer annually. This is a result of a small number of freshmen who apply for more than one program, for example a program in Theatre and in LAS.
