
DePaul Remains Largest Catholic University in Fall 2021

DePaul is the largest Catholic university in the nation and has been for 24 consecutive years, having exceeded St. John's University in total enrollment in 1998. DePaul enrolled 13% of the enrollment at the ten largest Catholic institutions in 2021.

DePaul's enrollment is 4% larger than the second largest Catholic institution. This year, Georgetown University (DC) replaced St. John's University (NY) as the second largest institution. From 2020 to 2021, Georgetown (DC) enrollment grew by 8.1%, with growth in both undergraduate and graduate

enrollment. Georgetown's enrollment is primarily graduate (64%), and growth at the graduate level contributed to the total enrollment increase. St. John's enrollment declined -2.4%, with declines at both the undergraduate and graduate levels.

St. John's University (NY), Marquette University (WI) and DePaul University declined in total enrollment from 2020 to 2021, while the remaining seven of the ten largest institutions saw increases.
