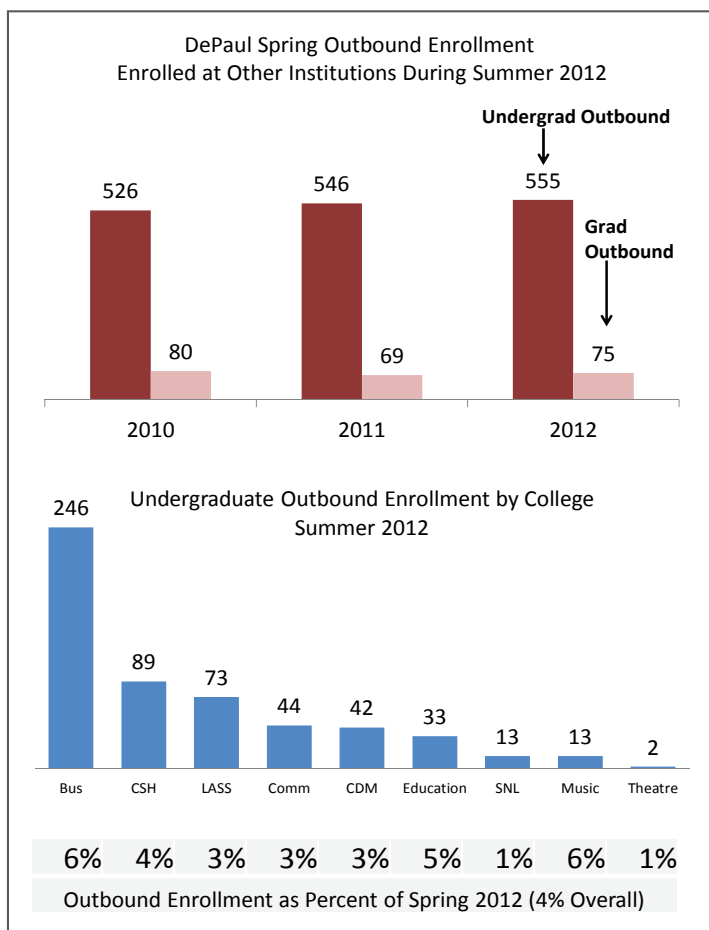
INFORMATION ON DEPAUL UNIVERSITY'S
MARKET PROMINENCE, POSITION AND PERFORMANCE

Nearly 600 Undergraduates Enroll Elsewhere in the Summer

In the summer of 2012, 8,311 students enrolled in courses at DePaul, generating a total of 48,829 credit hours. Most of these students were continuing DePaul students (92 percent). A total of 630 DePaul students (3 percent of spring 2012 enrollment) visited other institutions for summer courses, based on a recent analysis of data from the National Student Clearinghouse. Of these students, 114 (18 percent) were enrolled at both DePaul and their visiting institution during the summer term.

Undergraduates accounted for 88 percent of the outbound population, or 555 students, and 44 percent were from the College of Business.

Over the past three years, 95 percent of outbound undergraduates enrolled in two-year institutions. The top 17 destination institutions (those enrolling 10 or more students) accounted for 89 percent of all outbound enrollment—and all are two-year schools. The four-year destination institution with the largest summer enrollment of DePaul students was University of Wisconsin Milwaukee, enrolling a total of only six students over the past three years.
