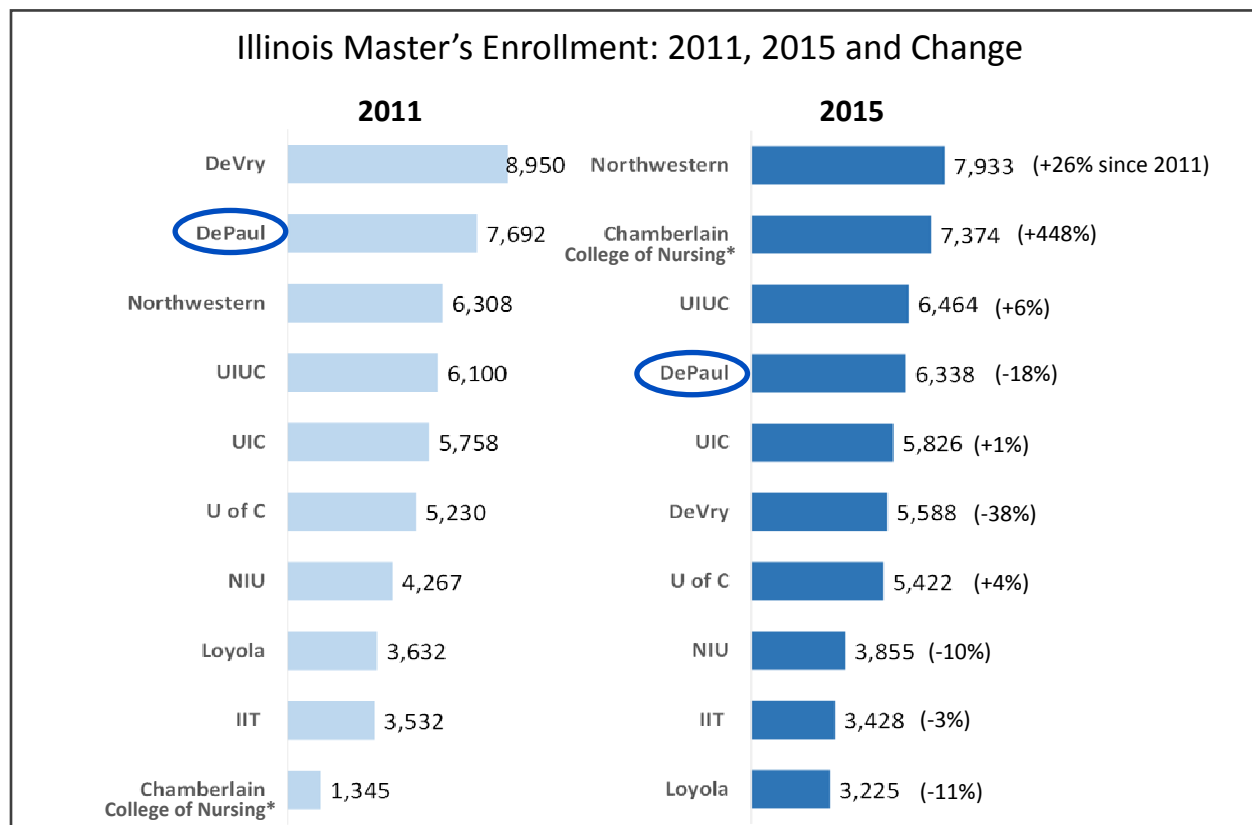
Illinois Master's Enrollment at Ten Largest Institutions

A total of 105,365 students enrolled in master's programs throughout Illinois in 2015, according to the most recent Illinois Board of Higher Education (IBHE) information. The 10 institutions enrolling the largest number of master's students accounted for over half (53 percent) of the enrollment statewide. Five of these institutions experienced enrollment declines between 2011 and 2015.

In 2015, seven of the 10 largest schools were private institutions. Together, these seven institutions enrolled over a third (37 percent) of all master's students.

Northwestern enrolled the largest number of master's students in Illinois, or 7,933 students, a 26 percent increase in master's enrollment since 2011. DePaul enrolled 6,338 master's students, dropping from second-largest enrollment in 2011 to the fourth-largest in 2015 after an 18 percent enrollment decline.

Statewide, master's enrollment reached a historic high in 2010 of 119,882 students and then declined until 2014 when the enrollment began to increase.
